

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

### **In Firefox, PDFs display with thin, scraggly, ill-spaced text.**

If PDF files display in a Firefox window, and the text is crisp and clear, the file is being displayed in Firefox's PDF viewer, which can cause this problem. To force Firefox to download PDFs and then display them in Adobe's full-featured Reader:

- Go to Firefox's Options (either click the orange Mozilla logo in the upper left-hand corner, or select Tools/Options).
- Select the Applications tab.
- Type *pdf* in the search bar, then press Enter.
- Click on the setting under the Action column and then click the down arrow to the right. Select the "Use Adobe Reader" option.
- Click the OK button.
